- 04.** 1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Arrangement (Virtual/Physical) Mode.
2. Heard learned counsel for the Petitioner and learned counsel for the Opposite Parties.
3. The Petitioner has filed the present Writ Petition with the following prayer:-

*“(i) The Hon’ble Tribunal be pleased to admit & allow the original Application,*

*(ii) The Hon’ble Tribunal be pleased to direct the respondents to sanction the 2<sup>nd</sup> RACP in favour of the applicant w.e.f.1.1.2013 @ Rs.9,300/--34,800/- with G.P. of Rs.4,600/- in view of the Finance Dept. Resolution dtd.6.2.2013 & letter dtd.20.1.2014 under Annexure-4 & 5 within a time bound period for the interest of justice.*

*(iv) The Hon’ble Tribunal may be pleased to pass any order(s)/direction(s) as deems fit and proper for the interest of justice.”*

4. Learned counsel for the Petitioner further submits that through highlighting his grievances, the petitioner has filed an application

at Annexure-7 to the Writ Petition before the O.P. No.1, but till date nothing has been done in the matter. In such background, learned counsel for the Petitioner prays that a direction be issued to Opposite Party No.1 to take a decision on the above noted Petition within a specific time period.

5. Considering the submissions made and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this Court directs Opposite Party No.1 to take a decision on the above noted petition taking into account Annexure-4 & 5 within a period of three (3) months from the date of receipt of this order and communicate the result of such exercise to the Petitioner.

6. The Writ Petition is disposed of accordingly.
