1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Arrangement (Virtual /Physical Mode).
 2. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned counsel for the State. Perused the record.
 3. The Petitioner has filed this Writ Petition seeking direction to the Opposite Parties to consider his case for regularization or for permanent absorption as against a regular base level post and release the remuneration/ arrears as applicable forthwith.
 4. In course of hearing, learned counsel for the Petitioner states that highlighting the grievances, the Petitioner has made a representation to Opposite Party No.3 vide Annexure-3/2 and the same may be directed to be considered within a stipulated time, to which learned Counsel for the State has no objection.
 5. As agreed to by learned Counsel for the parties, this Court, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, disposes of the Writ Petition directing Opposite Party No.3 to consider the

representation filed by the Petitioner vide Annexure-3/2, and pass appropriate order in accordance with law within a period of three months from the date of production of certified copy this order.
