This matter is taken up through hybrid mode.

2. The petitioners have filed this writ petition seeking direction to the opposite parties no.2 to 5 to evict/restrain opposite parties no.6 to 8 from making any construction over Plot No.165 under Khata No.137 of Mouza-Bijay Ramachandapur including the private road of the petitioners.

3. In course of hearing, learned counsel for the petitioners states that highlighting the grievances, the petitioners have made representation to the opposite party no.2 vide Annexure-6 and the same may be directed to be disposed of within a stipulated time, to which learned State Counsel has raised no objection.

4. As agreed to by learned counsel for the parties, however, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this writ petition stands disposed of directing the opposite party no.2 to consider the representation filed by the petitioners vide Annexure-6, and pass appropriate order in accordance with law within a period of three months from the date of production of certified copy of this order.
