1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Mode.

2. Heard learned counsel for the Parties.

3. The Writ Petition has been filed with the following prayer:-

“(i) The Hon’ble Tribunal be pleased to allow the original application and issue necessary direction to the respondents to pay all financial benefit on correct re-fixation of pay of the applicant for retrospective promotion w.e.f 09/10/74 in the cadre post of Junior SES and to pay the differential amount w.e.f 01/12.81 after fixation of his pay notionally for the period of creation of supernumerary post for retrospective effect promotion to the cadre post of Junior SES i.e. from 09/10/74 to 30/11/81 with all pecuniary and service benefits by considering the representation under Anenxure-4 as per Annexure-5 & 6 immediately within a time limit to be stipulated by this Hon’ble Tribunal. And the Hon’ble Tribunal is pleased to pass such other Order / Orders as it deemed fit and proper in facts and circumstances of this case”.

4. He further submits that through highlighting his grievances, the petitioner has filed a representation

on 26.12.2015 under Annexure-4 to the Writ Petition before the opposite party No.1 but till date nothing has been done in the matter. In such background, he prays that a direction be issued to opposite party no.4 to take a decision on the above noted petition within a specific time period.

5. Considering the submissions made and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this Court directs opposite party No.1 to take a decision on the above noted petition in accordance with law within a period of one month from the date of production of certified copy of this order and communicate the result of such exercise to the petitioner.

6. The Writ Petition is disposed of accordingly.
