01. 1. This matter is taken up through video conferencing mode.
2. The Petitioner being in custody in connection with Badabazar P.S. Case No.113 of 2021 corresponding to G.R. Case No.923 of 2021 on the file of learned S.D.J.M., Berhampur running for commission of offence under section 419/420 of the IPC read with section 66(C)/66(D) of the I.T. Act, has filed this application under section 439 of the Cr.P.C. for his release on bail.
3. Heard learned counsel for the Petitioner and learned counsel for the State.
4. Taking into account the submissions made; further keeping in view the materials on records as those stand against the Petitioner with other surrounding circumstances as also the

period of detention of the Petitioner in custody and on going through the order passed by the learned Special Judge (V) Berhampur; in the absence of any such impediment; it is directed that the Petitioner be released on bail in the aforesaid case on such terms and conditions as deemed just and proper by the court in seisin of the case with further condition that the Petitioner, without prejudice to his defence, would deposit a sum of Rs.6,000/- (rupees six thousand) before the said court, which shall be kept under long term fixed deposit in any Nationalized Bank and would be renewed from time to time as the court deems proper, whose disbursement/release shall be subject to the final order as would be passed at the conclusion of the trial..

5. The BLAPL is accordingly disposed of.
