This matter is taken up through hybrid mode.

The writ petition has been registered before this Court on 10th August, 2021, after the original application was transferred from the learned Orissa Administrative Tribunal, Cuttack Bench, Cuttack upon its abolition.

On perusal of the available order sheets of the learned Tribunal, it is indicated that the matter was never taken up after 03.03.2017.

It is submitted by the learned counsel for the petitioner that after unfortunate demise of the learned counsel who was engaged earlier, she has instruction to appear. It is further submitted that though the matter is pending since 2013 no counter affidavit has been filed before the learned Tribunal on behalf of the State. It is further submitted that she has no up-to-date instruction from the petitioner, at present to pursue the litigation.
