This matter is taken up through hybrid mode.

2. Heard learned counsel for the parties.

The petitioner has filed this writ petition seeking direction to the opposite parties to grant permission to open of BBA course with 120 seats which is pending before the opposite party no.2 since 30.11.2019 vide Annexure-1 and further seeks direction to issue permission for admission of students in BBA course for the academic session 2022-23.
4. In course of hearing, learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner has already made representation before the Opposite Party no.1 vide Annexure-2, and the same may be directed to be disposed of within a stipulated time, to which learned State Counsel has raised no objection.
