1. 1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Mode.
2. 2. Heard learned counsel for the Petitioner and learned counsel for the Opposite Parties.
3. 3. The Petitioner has filed the present Writ Petition for the following reliefs.

“(i) The Hon’ble Tribunal may be pleased to direct the respondents to regularize the services of the applicant since the services of the similarly situated persons have been already regularized under Annexure-5 on dated 03.05.2014 and accordingly in view of the facts and circumstances as stated above the respondents may be directed to take necessary steps and initiate the process of regularization of the applicant and the grade pay may be allowed and the respondents may also be directed to publish the gradation list as the first steps towards regularization and the grievance of the applicant as stated above in the representation under Annexure-8 dated 19.08.2014 may be considered for regularization of the services of the applicant as necessary.

(ii) Cost of the litigation may be awarded in favour of the applicant.

(iii) Any other reliefs as your lordships may deem fit and proper.

(iv) Accordingly, the present application may be allowed as prayed”.

4. Learned counsel for the Petitioner submits that the Petitioner has moved before Opposite Party No.1 seeking redressal of his grievance as made in the representation dated 19.08.2014 under Annexure-6 to the Writ Petition.

5. Considering the submissions made and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this Court directs Opposite Party No.1 to take a decision on the above noted representation of the Petitioner in accordance with law within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order and communicate the result thereof to the Petitioner.

6. With the aforesaid observation and direction the Writ Petition is disposed of.

7. Issue urgent certified copy of the order as per rules.
