1. Heard learned counsel for the Petitioner and the State.
2. This is an application for bail U/s.438 Cr.P.C. filed by the Petitioner in anticipation of arrest for his alleged involvement in the offences U/s.341/323/325/307/294/506/34 IPC.
3. Learned counsel for the State submits that the injury report has since been obtained and the nature of injury sustained by the injured is simple in nature.
4. Considering the aforesaid facts, the nature of allegations, the circumstances appearing, the seriousness and gravity of the offences, while this Court is not inclined to grant anticipatory bail, it is directed that in the event the Petitioner surrenders in connection with Purighat P.S. Case No.269 of 2022 corresponding to G.R. Case No.1405 of 2022 pending in the court of learned S.D.J.M.(S),

Cuttack within a period of two weeks' hence and moves for bail, he shall be released on such terms and conditions as would be deemed just and proper by the said court with further conditions that he shall appear in person before the court below on each date of posting of the case unless specifically exempted by the court concerned with the further conditions that he shall appear before the IO as and when required, shall not threaten or intimidate the Informant party in any manner whatsoever and shall cooperate with the investigation; shall not indulge in any other similar offence in any manner whatsoever while on bail. Violation of any of the conditions shall entail cancellation of bail of the Petitioners.

5. The ABLAPL is disposed of.
