1. 1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Mode.
2. Heard learned counsel for the Petitioner and learned counsel for the Opposite Parties.
3. The Petitioner has filed the present Writ Petition for the following reliefs.
 - “(i) to direct the respondents to protect the pay of the applicant by fixing at the stage of the time scale of Jr. S.E.S which is equal the pay in respect of Sr.S.E.S as on 01.09.2012.*
 - “(ii) to refix/fix the pay of the applicant as on 01.09.2012 as per Rule-74 (d) of the Orissa Service Code and pay the arrears differential due from 01.09.2012.*
 - “(iii) Consequently fix the pension w.e.f 01.05.2012 and sanction and pay the pension and other post retirement benefits within a stipulated time.*
 - “(iv) Allow the application with cost.*
4. Learned counsel for the Petitioner submits that the Petitioner has moved before Opposite Party No.1 seeking redressal of his grievance as made in the representation dated 08.09.2014 under Annexure-6 to the Writ Petition.

5. Considering the submissions made and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this Court directs Opposite Party No.1 to take a decision on the above noted representation of the Petitioner in accordance with law within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order and communicate the result thereof to the Petitioner.

6. With the aforesaid observation and direction the Writ Petition is disposed of.

7. Issue urgent certified copy of the order as per rules.
