- 1.** This matter is taken up through Hybrid Mode.
- 2.** Heard Mr. D.Mishra, learned counsel for the Petitioner and Mr. P.Bharatwaj, learned counsel for the State.
- 3.** It is submitted by Mr. Mishra, learned counsel for the Petitioner that in the meantime the Petitioner has been reinstated but he has not been extended with the salary for certain period.
- 4.** Accordingly, while disposing the Writ Petition liberty is granted to the Petitioner to make a fresh representation before Opposite Party No.2 with regard to non-release of salary within three weeks and in case such a representation is made, the same be considered by Opposite Party No.2 in accordance with law within a period of three months. The order so passed be also communicated to the Petitioner.
- 5.** The Writ Petition is accordingly disposed of.
