2. Heard learned counsel for the parties.

3. The petitioner has filed this writ petition seeking direction to opposite parties no.1 & 2 to pay the arrear salary of the petitioner for the period 17.10.1998 to 04.11.2012 with accrued interest minimum @ 7% per annum within a stipulated period.

In course of hearing, learned counsel for the petitioner states that highlighting the grievances, the petitioner has made representation to opposite party no.1 vide Annexure-7 and the same may be directed to be considered and disposed of within a stipulated time taking into consideration Annexure-5, to which learned State Counsel has raised no objection.

5. As agreed to by learned counsel for the parties, this Court, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, disposes of the writ petition directing opposite party

no.1 to consider the representation filed by the petitioner vide Annexure-7 and pass appropriate order in accordance with law taking into consideration Annexure-5 within a period of three months from the date of production of certified copy this order.
