1. This matter is taken up through video conferencing.
2. This is an application under Sec.439 Cr.P.C. for bail and the offences alleged are under Secs.498-A/304-B/302/34, I.P.C. and Sec.4 of the D.P. Act.
3. Heard learned counsel for the Petitioner as well as learned A.G.A. for the State-Opposite Party.
4. Upon hearing both the parties and upon perusal of the copy of the deposition of P.W.3 as well as the post mortem report and the answers of the Doctor to the query of the I.O., I am not inclined to release the petitioner on bail, who is the prime accused in the case. The prayer for bail is rejected.
5. The BLAPL is dismissed.
