This matter is taken up through hybrid mode.

On 16.02.2022, when the matter was taken up after hearing learned counsel for the parties, the following order was passed:-

“The writ petition having been transferred after abolition of the learned Orissa Administrative Tribunal has been registered before this Court on 26th November, 2021.

On perusal of the available order sheets of the learned OAT, it is found that after notice issued on 15.11.2012, the matter was never listed.

Learned counsel for the applicant/petitioner submits that he has no instruction for the present and will try to contact the petitioner, as such may be accommodated for a short time.
