1. This matter is taken up through Video Conferencing Mode.
2. Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner intends not to press the I.A. involving C.P.No.20 of 2019. It is in this recording, this Court finds since the pleading involving C.P.No.20 of 2019 is yet to be completed, the wife-opposite party herein to be provided at least a month time from the communication of this order, as a matter of last chance, to come up with her pleading and all endeavour should be made by the learned Judge, Family Court, Kendrapara to conclude the proceeding at least within a month from the date of completion of the pleading.
3. With this observation and direction, the writ petition stands disposed of.
