“(i) Admit the Writ Petition.

(ii) Issue of an appropriate writ order(s), direction (s) to the Opposite Party No.2, 3 & 4 for considering the representation of petitioners organization in Participating RPDAC meeting which will be held on 12.11.2022 on the office of Opposite Party No.3.

(iii) Pass such other or further orders as this Hon’ble Court may deem fit and proper in the facts and circumstances of the present case”.
