1. Heard learned counsel for the Petitioners and the State.
2. This is an application for bail U/s.438 Cr.P.C. filed by the Petitioners in anticipation of arrest for their alleged involvement in the offences U/s.341/294/323/506/34 IPC.
3. Learned counsel for the Petitioners submits that the present incident is with regard to the sale of “diya” during the “Diwali”. There is also a counter FIR from the side of the Petitioner against the informant party implicating by and large on the same offence.
4. Keeping in view the submission of the parties, the nature of allegations, the circumstances appearing, the seriousness and gravity of the offences, while this court is not inclined to grant the anticipatory bail, it is directed that in the event the Petitioners

surrender in connection with Dharuadihi P.S. Case No.131 of 2022 corresponding to G.R. Case No.1664 of 2022 pending in the court of learned S.D.J.M., Sundargarh within a period of two weeks' hence and moves for bail, they shall be released on such terms and conditions as would be deemed just and proper by the said court with further conditions that they shall appear in person before the court below on each date of posting of the case unless specifically exempted by the court concerned with the further conditions that they shall appear before the IO as and when required, shall not threaten or intimidate the Informant party in any manner whatsoever and shall cooperate with the investigation.

5. The ABLAPL is disposed of.
