2. Heard.

3. The petitioner has filed this writ petition seeking direction to the opposite party no.1 to initiate a proceeding under the provisions of EPF & MP Act, 1952 against the opposite party no.2 for recovery of EPF dues, contribution for the period from 09.06.2011 to 24.08.2021.

4. In course of hearing, learned counsel for the petitioner states that highlighting the grievance, the petitioner has made representation to the opposite party no.1 vide Annexure-8 and direction may be given to consider and dispose of the same, within a stipulated time.
