This matter is taken up through hybrid mode.

2. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner.

3. The petitioner has filed this writ petition seeking to quash the order under Annexure-7 and declare the decision to fill up only 69 posts as illegal. He further seeks direction to the opposite parties to issue order of appointment in his favour.

In course of hearing, learned counsel for the petitioner states that highlighting the grievances, the petitioner has made representation to opposite party no.2 vide Annexure-8 and the same may be directed to be considered within a stipulated time, to which learned State Counsel has no objection.
