1. This matter is taken up through virtual mode.
2. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned Additional Standing Counsel for the State.
3. The petitioner is in custody since 16.10.2021 in connection with Special Case No. 53 of 2021 (NDPS) arising out of Boudh P.S. Case No. 259 of 2021 pending in the court of learned Special Judge, Boudh for the alleged commission of offence under Sections 20(b)(ii)(B) of the NDPS Act.
4. Having regard to the submissions made, the materials on record, the period of detention already undergone and the fact that the seized contraband is less than commercial quantity being 14 Kg., I am inclined to allow the prayer for bail. Let the petitioner be released on bail on such terms and conditions as the court in seisin over the matter may deem fit and proper to impose including the condition that he shall personally appear before the trial court on each date of posting of the case without fail.

5. The BLAPL is accordingly disposed of.
