1. Heard learned counsel for the Petitioner and the State.
2. This is an application for bail U/s. 438 Cr.P.C. filed by the Petitioner in apprehension of arrest for his alleged involvement in the offences U/s. 341/354/354-A of IPC.
3. Learned counsel for the Petitioner submits that the present Petitioner is a doctor and due to personal vendetta he has falsely been implicated in this case.
4. Learned counsel for the State vehemently opposed the prayer for anticipatory bail.
5. Keeping in view the nature of allegations as emerged from the materials on record, the circumstances appearing, the seriousness and gravity of the offences, it is directed that in the event the Petitioner surrenders and moves for bail in connection with

Nabarangapur P.S. Case No. 534 of 2022 corresponding to G.R. Case No.1285 of 2022 pending in the court of learned S.D.J.M., Nabarangapur within a period of three weeks hence and he shall be admitted to go on bail on such terms and conditions as would be deemed just and proper by the said court with further conditions that the Petitioner shall appear in person before the learned court below on each date of posting of the case; shall appear before the I.O. and shall cooperate with the investigation as and when required; shall not threaten, intimidate or terrorize or influence the Informant in any manner; shall not tamper with the prosecution evidence in any manner whatsoever and shall not indulge in any other crime of similar nature to the present case in any manner whatsoever, while on bail. Violation of any of the conditions shall entail cancellation of bail.

6. The ABLAPL is disposed of accordingly.
