- 01.** 1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Arrangement (Virtual/Physical) Mode.
2. Heard learned counsel for the Petitioner and learned counsel for the Opposite Parties.
3. The Petitioner has filed the present Writ Petition with the following prayer:-

“In view of the facts stated in para-6 above, it is ardently prayed that your lordships may kindly be pleased to quash the orders under Annexure- 6 and 7 and direct the Respondent No. 4 to regularize the leave period of the applicant from 3.8.13 to 24.2.14 as EL and sanction the financial benefits in favour of the applicant within a time stipulated as fixed by this Tribunal.

And pass any other order/orders as deemed fit and proper in the interest of justice, equity and good conscience.

And for which act of your kindness the applicant shall as on duty bound ever pray.”

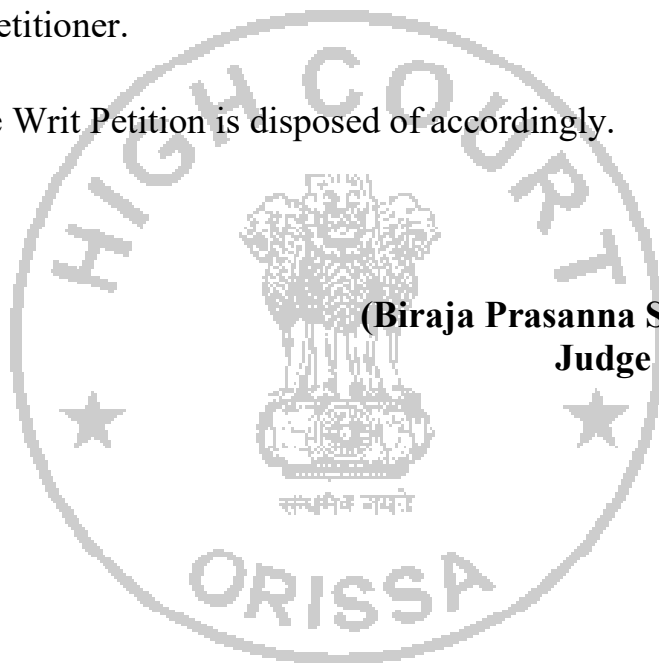
4. Learned counsel for the Petitioner further submits that through highlighting his grievances, the petitioner has filed an application at Annexure-8 to the Writ Petition before the O.P. No.2, but till

date nothing has been done in the matter. In such background, learned counsel for the Petitioner prays that a direction be issued to Opposite Party No.2 to take a decision on the above noted Petition within a specific time period.

5. Considering the submissions made and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this Court directs Opposite Party No.2 to take a decision on the above noted petition in accordance with law within a period of three (3) months from the date of receipt of this order and communicate the result of such exercise to the Petitioner.

6. The Writ Petition is disposed of accordingly.
