The Petitioner has filed this Writ Petition seeking direction to the opposite parties to draw/disburse the salaries of the Petitioner for the period from August 2014 to November, 2015 and May 2015 to July 2015 and periodical increments for the period from 2014 to 2016 along with 2nd financial upgradation.
