This matter is taken up through hybrid mode.

2. Heard learned counsel for the parties.

The petitioner has filed this writ petition seeking to quash the order dated 01.10.2022 under Annexure-4 with regard to engagement of Saraswati Malik as “LCCA” Sadanadapur Sevashram, Bhadrak Block, Bhadrak and to direct the opposite party nos. 2 and 3 to engage the petitioner as “LCCA” for Sadanadapur Sevashram.

In course of hearing, learned counsel for the petitioner states that highlighting the grievances, the petitioner has made representation to the opposite party no.1 vide Annexure-5 and the same may be directed to be disposed of within a stipulated, to which learned State Counsel has raised no objection.
