This matter is taken up through hybrid mode.

The writ petition has been registered before this Court on 1st December, 2021, after the original application was transferred from the learned State Administrative Tribunal upon its abolition.

On perusal of the available order sheets of the learned Tribunal, it is indicated that the matter was never taken up after 16.03.2018.

It is submitted by the learned counsel for the applicant/petitioner that the matter pertains to Corrigendum dated 20.05.2008 and there has been no interim order regarding selection process and the result thereof.
