04. 1. This matter is taken up through hybrid arrangement (virtual/physical) mode.
2. The Petitioner having been implicated in Binjharpur P.S. Case No.263 of 2019 corresponding to C.T. Case No.1177 of 2019 registered for alleged commission of offence under section 417/420/294/354/323/506/507 of the IPC pending on the file of learned S.D.J.M., Jajpur, has filed this application for grant of anticipatory bail.
3. Heard learned counsel for the Petitioner and learned counsel for the State.
4. Considering the submissions and viewing the materials on record as also other surrounding circumstances, while being not inclined to grant of anticipatory bail to the Petitioner, this application is disposed of with the observation that in the event

the Petitioner surrenders before the court in seisin of the aforesaid case and moves for his release on bail, the same shall be considered on its own merit and disposed of early in accordance with law so as to enable the Petitioner to approach the next higher forum early in case necessity so arises.

Interim order passed on 02.02.2021 stands vacated.

5. The ABLAPL is accordingly disposed of.
