This matter is taken up through hybrid mode.

The writ petition has been registered before this Court on 1st December, 2021, after the original application was transferred from the learned State Administrative Tribunal upon its abolition.

On perusal of the available order sheets of the learned Tribunal, it is indicated that the matter was never taken up after 01.05.2015. Further, the matter was dismissed for non-prosecution on 06.09.2013, restored to the file of the learned Tribunal on 24.03.2015 and after the said date, it has never been taken up.
