This matter is taken up through hybrid mode.

2. The petitioner has filed this writ petition seeking to set aside para-13 of Annexure-4 dated 14.12.2009 and to issue direction to the opposite parties to modify the age of superannuation of Govt. College Teachers from 58 to 65 years and also direct that the petitioner will be deemed to be continuing up to attaining the age of superannuation, i.e., 65 years along with all service and financial benefits.

In course of hearing, learned counsel for the petitioner states that highlighting the grievances, the petitioner has made representation to the opposite party no.2 vide Annexure-6 and the same may be directed to be disposed of within a stipulated time, to which learned State Counsel has raised no objection.
4. As agreed by learned counsel for the parties, this Court without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, disposes of the writ petition directing opposite party no.2 to consider the representation filed by the petitioner vide

Annexure-6, and pass appropriate order in accordance with law within a period of three months from the date of production/communication of certified copy of this order.
