This matter is taken up by hybrid mode.

2. The petitioner has filed this writ petition seeking direction to opposite parties to release the legitimate arrear salary of the petitioner for the period from 26.11.1989 to 16.06.2006 in the trained graduate scale of pay, within a stipulated time.

In course of hearing, learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner has already made representation before opposite party no.2 vide Annexure-13, and the same may be directed to be disposed of within a stipulated time taking into consideration Annexure-7 within a stipulated time, to which learned State Counsel has raised no objection.

4. As agreed by learned counsel for the parties, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this writ
