01. This matter is taken up through Hybrid arrangement (video conferencing/physical mode).

Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned counsel for the State.

This is an application under section 439 of Cr.P.C. in connection with C.T. Case No.4794 of 2022 arising out of Bharatpur P.S. Case No.316 of 2022 pending in the Court of learned S.D.J.M., Bhubaneswar for offences punishable under sections 341/294/323/506/376(2)(n) of the Indian Penal Code.

The prayer for bail of the petitioner was rejected by the learned Additional Sessions Judge, Bhubaneswar vide order dated 31.10.2022.

Considering the submission made by the learned counsel

for the petitioner that the petitioner is in judicial custody since 28.09.2022 and he has been charge sheeted under sections 341/294/323/506/376(2)(n) of the Indian Penal Code and after going through the 164 Cr.P.C. statement of the victim, who is aged about twenty one years and on hearing the learned counsel for the State, I am inclined to release the petitioner on bail.

Let the petitioner be released on bail in the aforesaid case on furnishing a bail bond of Rs.50,000/- (rupees fifty thousand) with two local solvent sureties each for the like amount to the satisfaction of the learned Court in seisin over the matter with further conditions as the learned Court may deem just and proper subject to conditions that the petitioner shall not try to keep in contact with the victim or any of the prosecution witnesses or tamper with the evidence, he shall not indulge in any criminal activities in any manner and he shall appear before the learned trial Court on each date when the case would be posted for trial.

Violation of any terms and conditions shall entail cancellation of bail.

Accordingly, the BLAPL is disposed of.
