2. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner.

3. The petitioner has filed this writ petition seeking to quash the revision order dated 12.12.2002 under Annexure-5. She further seeks direction to the opposite parties to treat the period from 12.12.2002 to 17.12.2002 as S.I. and continuous and fix her pay at Rs.5,770/- w.e.f 01.10.2002 and sanction all arrear salary and revise her pension accordingly.

In course of hearing, learned counsel for the petitioner states that highlighting the grievances, the petitioner has made representation to opposite party no.2 vide Annexure-11 and the same may be directed to be considered within a stipulated time, to which learned State Counsel has no objection.
