1. This matter is taken up through video conferencing.
2. This is an application under Sec.439 Cr.P.C. for bail and the offences alleged are under Secs.417/418/420/464/465/468/471/34, I.P.C.
3. Heard Mr. A.R. Panda, learned counsel for the Petitioner as well as Mr. G. Rout, learned A.S.C. for the State-Opposite Party.
4. It is submitted that the Petitioner is inside custody since 13.10.2021 and as per the allegations the amounts have been given to the co-accused, Sanjay Nayak. It is further submitted that in the meantime investigation has been completed.
5. Upon hearing learned A.S.C. for the State-Opposite Party and considering the period of detention of the Petitioner inside

custody as well as the nature of materials appearing against him, it is directed to release the Petitioner on bail in connection with Bampada Industrial Area P.S. Case No.159/2019 corresponding to C.T. Case No.1266/2019 on such terms and conditions to be fixed by the learned S.D.J.M., Balasore as he deems just and proper including the condition that the Petitioner shall not be involved in any other offence while on bail.

6. The BLAPL is accordingly disposed of.

As the restrictions due to resurgence of COVID-19 situation are continuing, learned counsel for the parties may utilize a printout of the order available in the High Court's website, at par with certified copy, subject to attestation by the concerned advocate, in the manner prescribed vide Court's Notice No.4587, dated 25th March, 2020 as modified by Court's Notice No.4798, dated 15th April, 2021 and Court's Office Order circulated vide Memo No.514, dated 7th January, 2022.
