1. This matter is taken up through hybrid mode.
2. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned counsel for the State.
3. Learned counsel for the State on instruction submits that informant has been duly noticed.

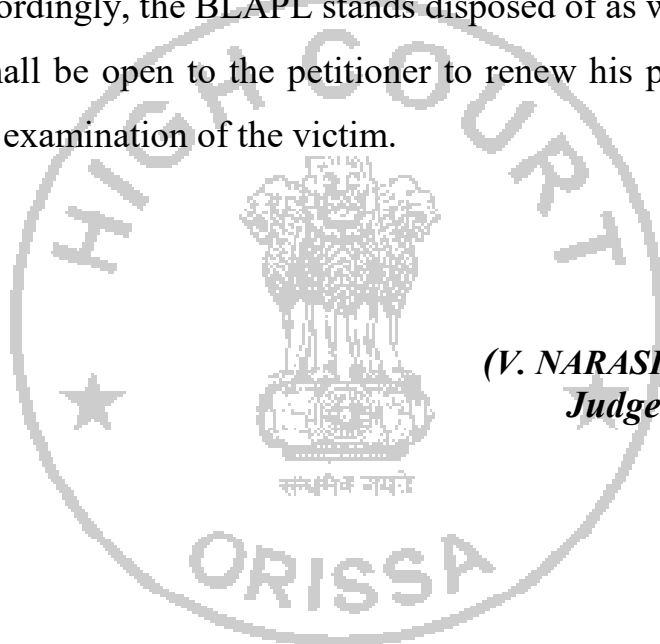
7. Perused the 164 Cr.P.C. statement of the victim and friend of the victim and the medical examination report.
