1. Heard learned counsel for the Parties.

Learned counsel for the Petitioner submits that the demarcation proceeding involving the notice under Annexure-1 remains unexecutable, for there is already existence of the R.I. report as clearly appearing at page-11 of the brief thereby observing that the demarcation of the land is unsurveyable.

Keeping in view the submission of learned counsel for the Petitioner to the notice at Annexure-1 and the report at page-11, this Court permits the Petitioner to raise objection in the proceeding posted to tomorrow (19.11.2022) before the Tahasildar, Byasanagar- Opposite Party No.4. In the event such objection, is raised, the Tahasildar, Byasanagar shall do well in first taking a decision on the objection of the Petitioner before proceeding to undertake the demarcation exercise.

4. The Writ Petition stands disposed of.
