This matter is taken up through hybrid mode.

2. The petitioner has filed this writ petition seeking direction to opposite parties no.3 and 4 to fix her seniority above the opposite party no.6 as Swechhasevi Sikshya Sahayak and declare her as Junior Teacher with effect from 16.07.2007 in place of 28.10.2007 and regular primary school teacher w.e.f. 16.07.2009 in place of 28.10.2009, and grant all consequential service and financial benefits within a stipulated time.

3. In course of hearing, learned counsel for the petitioner states that highlighting the grievances, the petitioner has made representation to the opposite party no.2 vide Annexure-5 and the same may be directed to be disposed of within a stipulated time, to which learned State Counsel has raised no objection.

4. As agreed by learned counsel for the parties, this Court without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, disposes of the writ petition directing opposite party no.2

to consider the representation filed by the petitioner vide Annexure-5, and pass appropriate order in accordance with law within a period of three months from the date of production/communication of certified copy of this order.
