This matter is taken up through hybrid mode.

The petitioner has filed this writ petition seeking direction to opposite parties to count the service of the petitioner rendered as Sikhya Karmi for the purpose of all service benefits including retirement benefits and her seniority may be reckoned from the date she joined as sikhya karmi along with all consequential service and financial benefits.

In course of hearing, learned counsel for the petitioner states that highlighting the grievances, the petitioner has made representation to the opposite party no.1 vide Annexure-4 and the same may be directed to be disposed of within a stipulated time, to which learned State Counsel has raised no objection.
