- 1.** 1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Mode.
- 2.** 2. Heard Mr. Mohapatra, learned counsel appearing on behalf of Mr. U.K.Samal, learned counsel for the Petitioner and Mr. Praharaj, learned counsel for the State.
- 3.** 3. It is submitted by Mr. Mohapatra, learned counsel for the Petitioner that the petitioner has retired in the meantime and he is entitled to get some financial benefit from the State-Opposite Parties.
- 4.** 4. Accordingly, he prays for disposal of the case with liberty to make a fresh application before the competent authority within a period of three weeks.
- 5.** 5. It is observed that if such an application is filed within the aforesaid period, the same shall be considered and disposed of on its own merit within a period of three months from the date of receipt of such application.
- 6.** 6. With the aforesaid observation and direction, the Writ Petition (OAC) is disposed of.
