2. Heard learned counsel for the parties.

3. The petitioners have filed this writ petition seeking direction to opposite party no.1 to disburse their arrear salary w.e.f. 01.01.2016 to 31.09.2017 as due and admissible to them within a stipulated period.

In course of hearing, learned counsel for the petitioner states that highlighting the grievances, the petitioner has made representation to opposite party no.1 vide Annexure-10 and the same may be directed to be considered and disposed of within a stipulated time taking into consideration Annexure-5, to which learned State Counsel has raised no objection.
