3. The petitioner has filed this writ petition seeking direction to the opposite parties to upgrade the Asst. Accountant post to the post of Head Clerk like Agriculture Section and equalize all the service benefit and grant the benefits i.e. Pay Band and Grade Pay as per RACP Rules.

In course of hearing, learned counsel for the petitioner states that highlighting the grievances, the petitioner has made representation to opposite party no.2 vide Annexure-5 and the same may be directed to be considered taking into consideration Annexure-6 within a stipulated time, to which learned State Counsel has no objection.
