The petitioner has filed this writ petition seeking direction to opposite party no.4 to take necessary for stepping of up pay, ACP, Green Card facilities and salary from November, 2016 to 3rd December, 2016 and sent the LPC and Service Book of the petitioner to his present place of posting so that he can draw his current salary.
