3. The petitioner has filed this writ petition challenging the order passed by the Sub Collector, Jajpur dated 21.10.2022 in Annexure-5, under Section 13 (1) of the OPLE Act.

Dhal, learned Additional Government Advocate raised preliminary objection with regard to the maintainability of the writ petition and contended the order impugned is revisable one under Section 12 (2) of the OPLE Act.
