1. This matter is taken up through virtual mode.
2. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned Additional Standing Counsel for the State.
3. The petitioner is in custody since 18.10.2021 in connection with Kandarpur P.S. Case No. 214 of 2021 corresponding to G.R. Case No. 2139 of 2021 pending in the court of learned J.M.F.C., (R), Cuttack for the alleged commission of offence under Section 394 of IPC read with Sections 25 and 27 of the Arms Act.

Having regard to the submissions made, the materials on record, the period of detention already undergone and the fact that the petitioner appears to have been implicated in the case on suspicion, I am inclined to allow the prayer for bail. Let the petitioner be released on bail on such terms and conditions as the court in seisin over the matter may deem fit and proper to impose including the condition that he shall appear before the IIC of Chandpur Police Station on every Sunday at 10.30 AM

till submission of final form.
