The petitioner has filed this writ petition seeking direction to pay his arrear salary for the period he had discharged his duties as recommended by opposite party no.4 vide Annexure-4 dated 04.09.2015 and further to direct opposite party no.2 to dispose of his representation vide Annexure-5 within a stipulated period.
 4. In course of hearing, learned counsel for the petitioner states that highlighting the grievances, the petitioner has made representation to opposite party no.2 vide Annexure-5 and the same may be directed to be considered within a stipulated time, to which learned State Counsel has no objection.
