1. This matter is taken up through hybrid mode.
2. The writ petition has been registered before this Court on 24.1.2022 after the Original Application was transferred from the learned Odisha Administrative Tribunal, Cuttack Bench, Cuttack upon its abolition.
3. On perusal of the available order sheets of the learned Tribunal, it is indicated that notices on admission were issued on 09.02.2018 directing to file counter within four weeks and rejoinder was to be filed within two weeks thereafter. In the interim, the Tribunal directed as follows:-

“So far as prayer for interim prayer is concerned, it is made clear that during pendency of the O.A. there is no bar for the authority to consider the representation of the applicant dt.5.7.2017 at Annexure-7.”

The matter was never taken up/pursued thereafter.
