01. 1. Heard learned counsel for the Petitioners and the State.
2. This is an application for bail U/s. 438 Cr.P.C. filed by the Petitioners in apprehension of arrest for their alleged involvement in the offences U/s. 498-A/323/307/494/506/406/34 of IPC.
3. Apparently it appears from the record that the Petitioners have been implicated in this case U/s. 494 IPC and extended threat to the Informant implicating them U/s. 506 IPC. However as regards the present petitioners there appears no direct allegation as to the offence U/s.394 subject of course the evidence to come during trial.
4. Prima facie, therefore, keeping in view the submission of the parties, the nature of allegations as emerged from the materials on record, the circumstances appearing, the seriousness and gravity of the offences, it is directed that in the event the Petitioners surrender and move for bail in connection with Paradeep P.S. Case No.365 of

2022 corresponding to G.R. Case No.1112 of 2022 pending in the court of learned J.M.F.C.(P), Kujang within a period of three weeks hence and move for bail, they shall be released on such terms and conditions as would be deemed just and proper by the said court.

With the following further conditions:-

- (i) The Petitioners shall appear before the I.O. and shall cooperate with the investigation as and when required.
- (ii) They shall also appear before the trial court on each date of trial, without fail, till conclusion of the trial;
- (iii) They shall not tamper with the prosecution evidence in any manner whatsoever;
- (iv) They shall not indulge in any other crime of similar nature to the present case, in any manner whatsoever, while on bail.

Violation of any of the conditions shall entail cancellation of bail.

5. The ABLAPL is disposed of accordingly.
