3. The petitioner has filed this writ petition seeking to quash the relieve memo no.1090 dated 28.02.2017 passed by opposite party no.1 retiring him on 28.02.2017 and he shall be deemed to have worked till 28.02.2019 as per his date of birth recorded in his Service Book with all service benefits.
