1. 1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Mode.
2. Heard learned counsel for the parties.
3. The Petitioner has filed the present Writ Petition with the following prayer:-

“The Hon’ble Tribunal may be pleased to declare that the revision of pay of the applicant as per ORSP Rules, 2017 as at Annexure-4 dtd.27.10.2017 is illegal so far as applicant is concerned and direct the respondents to re-fix the pay of the applicant as per his representation and option exercised under Annexure-5 & 5/1 dtd.3.11.2017 and the Hon’ble Tribunal may be pleased to direct the respondents to release the differential salary on such re-fixation within a time bound period.”

4. He further submits that through highlighting his grievances, the petitioner has filed a representation dated 18.12.2017 under Annexure-6 series to the Writ Petition, but till date nothing has been done in the matter. In such background, he prays that a direction be issued to opposite party No.2 to take a decision on the above noted petition within a specific time period.
5. Considering the submissions made and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this

Court directs opposite party No.2 to take a decision on the above noted petition in accordance with law and taking into account Annexure-5/1, within a period of three months from the date of production of certified copy of this order and communicate the result of such exercise to the petitioner.

6. The Writ Petition is disposed of accordingly.
