In course of hearing, learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner has already made representation before opposite party no.5 vide Annexure-9, and the same may be directed to be disposed of within a stipulated time taking into consideration the order dated 09.09.2021 passed in W.P.(C) No. 19951 of 2020 and the order dated 29.04.2021 passed by the Executive Engineer, R.W. Division, Dhenkanal, and pass a reasoned and speaking order as expeditiously as possible, preferably within a period of three months from the date of receipt of the certified copy of this order.
