01. 1. This matter is taken up by video conferencing mode.
2. The Petitioner being in custody in connection with Bansada P.S. Case No.175 of 2021 corresponding to G.R. Case No.383 of 2021 on the file of the learned J.M.F.C., Chandabali running for commission of offence under sections 452/341/323/294/307/302/506/34 of the IPC, has filed this application under section 439 of the Cr.P.C. for his release on bail in the above mentioned case.
3. Heard learned counsel for the Petitioner and learned counsel for the State as well as learned counsel for the Informant.
4. Taking into account the submissions made; further keeping in view the materials on records those stand against the Petitioner and on going through the order passed by the learned
