2. Heard learned counsel for the parties.
3. The petitioner has filed this writ petition seeking direction to the opposite parties to extend the benefit under compassionate allowance under Rule 46 of the OCS Pension Rules, 1992 as her husband has worked in the department for 21 years and further to issue direction to the opposite parties to provide an employment under Rehabilitation Assistance Scheme to her eldest son.
4. In course of hearing, learned counsel for the petitioner states that highlighting the grievances, the petitioner has made representation to opposite party no.2 vide Annexure-6 and the same may be directed to be considered within a stipulated time, to which learned State Counsel has no objection.
5. As agreed by the learned counsel for the parties, this Court, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, disposes of the writ petition directing opposite party no.2 to consider the representation filed by the petitioner

vide Annexure-6 and pass appropriate order in accordance with law within a period of three months from the date of production of certified copy this order.
